<b>Course Description</b>		The headlines scream. The television blares: another workplace violence incident and this time it’s close to home. What the experts tell us is that there are steps we can and must take to minimize the incidence or severity of workplace violence. It is so important to take simple precautions at work to allow us the maximum chance of preventing or escaping injury if violence happens.	
<b>Highlights</b>		Learn how to set up an office, vary behavior so there is not a pattern established and to recognize the signs that violence may be coming. Those activities could and have saved lives. Recognize, through vast statistics, who potential offenders are, and learn to see and prevent escalation.
